This is a recommended reading list for children in Year 1 of picture books and first chapter books which have been carefully selected by teachers and librarians.

There are over 40 high-quality picture book texts and poetry books for 5-6-year-olds, all featuring rich language and engaging illustrations. There are lots of choices to suit all abilities with a wide variety of suggested picture books, emerging reader books, and first chapter books.

These stories include texts to encourage shared reading, individual reading, reading aloud, and reading for pleasure. There are books to share, to inspire a love of independent reading, and for reading with parents at home. There are easy readers, more challenging emerging reader chapter books and high-interest books to appeal to reluctant readers.

This is a crucial time in your child's education where they will make the most significant and visible leaps in progress. Children will have developed some ability to read on their own and will have the confidence to choose books for themselves. They need access to a variety of picture books to cater for their ability and interests. We hope you find some great books which spark a love of reading and thirst for knowledge and understanding in your child.
